Call Before You Dig

In the U.S., it is crucial to contact 811, the national “Call Before You Dig” service, prior to any excavation. Utility companies will mark their lines, reducing the risk of hitting fiber optic cables or other utilities. This step is both a safety and legal requirement, as many states mandate notification before digging .

Ground-Penetrating Radar (GPR)

GPR is a non-invasive method that uses radar pulses to create images of subsurface objects. It is highly effective for detecting buried fiber optic cables, especially in non-metallic environments. GPR provides accurate detection with minimal environmental impact, though it requires skilled operators and specialized equipment .
