

How to fuse two pigtails into a single-insertion cable

Two pigtails can be fused into a single-insertion cable using either a wire nut or pigtail splice for electrical wires, or a fusion splicer for fiber optic cables, ensuring a secure, low-loss connection.

Electrical Wire Pigtail Splicing

To combine two electrical pigtails into a single wire for insertion into a breaker or terminal:

- **Strip the Wires:** Remove insulation from the ends of both pigtails and a short third wire (the pigtail to the breaker) to expose the conductor.
- **Form the Splice:** Cross the stripped ends in an X shape. Bend one wire around the other to create an interlocking twist, ensuring all strands are intertwined for a tight connection.
- **Secure the Connection:** Use a wire nut or push-in connector rated for the wire gauge. Make sure the connector is compatible with copper or aluminum wiring as needed.
- **Insert the Single Wire:** Connect the short pigtail to the breaker or terminal, leaving the original two wires spliced together safely inside the panel . Tips: Avoid soldering in panel splices; wire nuts are safer and easier to manage. Ensure the splice is tight and fully covered by the connector to prevent loose connections .
