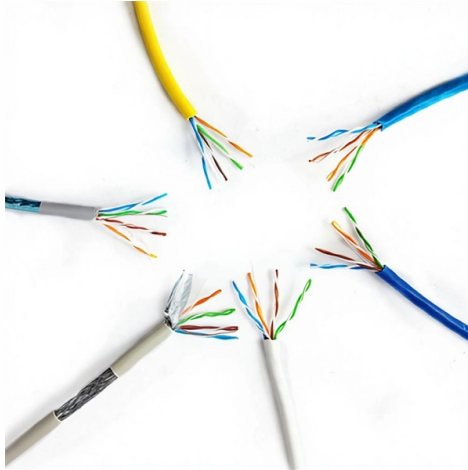


How to handle too many circuits in a distribution box
