

How to install a mobile fiber optic splitter

- For splitters with connectors: Insert the splitter into a fiber distribution or terminal box. Secure the main stainless steel tube in the designated slot or protective clamp. Connect the fiber connectors to adapters and coil any excess fiber neatly .
