

How to install a sealed distribution box

Installing a sealed distribution box requires careful placement, secure mounting, proper wiring, and ensuring the enclosure is fully protected against water and dust.

Step 1: Choose the Installation Location

Select a dry, accessible, and well-ventilated area for the distribution box. Ensure it is away from water, flammable, corrosive, or explosive substances. For outdoor installations, choose a location that allows for waterproofing and consider adding a rain cover or dehumidifier if necessary. The recommended height for residential boxes is around 1.5 meters above the ground, while industrial boxes may vary depending on surrounding equipment and space .

Step 2: Prepare the Box and Tools

Use a sealed electrical enclosure with an appropriate IP or NEMA rating (e.g., IP66 or NEMA 4 for outdoor use) to protect internal components from water, dust, and damage. Gather tools such as screwdrivers, wire strippers, cable ties, and an insulation resistance tester .

Step 3: Mount the Distribution Box

Place the box on a stable surface and align it with expansion bolts. Tighten screws securely to ensure the box is level and stable, without tilting or looseness. For outdoor boxes, ensure the seal is intact and add any additional waterproofing as needed .

Step 4: Prepare and Connect Wires

- Strip insulation from wires to expose the conductor, leaving an appropriate length.
