

How to install the distribution boxes separately

To install distribution boxes separately, choose a safe, accessible location, mount the enclosure securely, connect circuits individually, and ensure proper labeling and testing.

Step 1: Choose the Installation Location

Select a dry, accessible area with good ventilation, away from water, flammable, or corrosive substances . For residential setups, a height of about 1.5 meters above the ground is recommended, while industrial installations may vary depending on surrounding equipment . Ensure the location is close to the main power supply for easier connection and future maintenance.

Step 2: Select the Appropriate Enclosure

Choose a distribution box with the correct IP or NEMA rating based on indoor or outdoor use. For outdoor installations, consider IP66 or NEMA 4 enclosures to protect against rain, dust, and sunlight . The enclosure should be large enough to accommodate wiring, circuit breakers, and allow for future expansion.

Step 3: Mount the Distribution Box

Place the box on a stable surface and align it with expansion bolts. Secure it firmly to prevent tilting or loosening . Leave sufficient space around the box for ventilation and maintenance.
