

How to make a flat bend in a cable tray

Flat bends in cable trays can be made on-site using proper cutting, measuring, and bending techniques without expensive fittings, ensuring smooth cable routing and structural integrity.

Tools and Safety

To make flat bends, you will need:

- Bolt cutter or cable cutter
- Pliers or nose pliers
- Measuring tape and marker/chalk
- Hand gloves for safety
- Optional: metal bar or bending machine for steel trays Always wear gloves and mark the bend area clearly before cutting. Avoid sharp bends that could damage cables or compromise tray strength .

Step-by-Step Process for Wire Mesh Cable Trays

- Mark the Bend Area: Measure and mark the center line of the tray where the bend is required.
- Cutting: For a 90° flat bend, cut the tray partially along the center line, leaving enough material to maintain structural integrity .
- Remove Lip: File or cut the tray lip that will overlap during bending. For a 45° bend, calculate half the angle (22.5°) and mark the lip accordingly .
