

How to open the panel hole of the electrical distribution box

To open a panel hole in an electrical distribution box, you need to remove a knockout (KO) using a screwdriver, hammer, and pliers while ensuring the power is off and safety precautions are followed.

Step-by-Step Guide

1. Ensure Safety First Before starting, turn off the power to the panel at the main breaker and verify with a multimeter or voltage tester that no electricity is flowing to the area you will work on . Wear insulated gloves, safety goggles, and avoid standing on wet surfaces to reduce the risk of shock . 2. Remove the Panel Door Unscrew the screws holding the panel door to gain better access to the interior. This prevents the door from obstructing your work and allows you to handle the knockout more easily . 3. Locate the Knockout Knockouts are prefabricated metal pieces covering empty spaces in the panel. Identify the KO of the size needed for your conduit or wiring . 4. Loosen the Knockout

- Insert a flat-head screwdriver into the small slot or slit of the knockout.
- Tap the end of the screwdriver lightly with a hammer to bend the knockout inward. The goal is to create a corner you can grip, not to forcefully break it . 5. Remove the Knockout
- Grip the bent corner with pliers and twist back and forth.
- This action will snap the tabs holding the knockout in place, releasing it from the panel .
