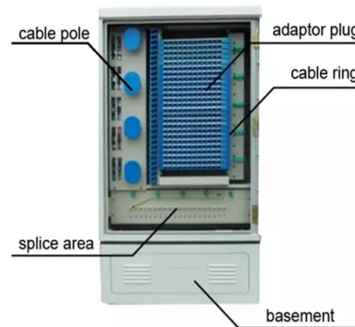


How to position cable trays on a construction site



Article Overview

Cable trays should be positioned according to approved shop drawings, with proper support, clearance, and alignment to ensure safety, accessibility, and compliance with NEC standards.

Planning and Preparation

Before positioning cable trays, review the approved shop drawings to determine the exact routes, lengths, and locations of trays and ladders in the building . Ensure the site is cleared and ready for installation, with all materials inspected for damage and compliance with project specifications . Store trays horizontally on a flat surface with timber supports at intervals of about one meter, protecting them from moisture and sunlight .

Tray Layout and Alignment

- **Horizontal and Vertical Runs:** Mark the tray routes according to the drawings, ensuring only horizontal and vertical runs unless otherwise specified .
- **Clearances:** Maintain at least 12 inches of vertical clearance above trays for installation and maintenance access, and ensure sufficient space for cable pulling and future maintenance .
- **Avoid Clashes:** Coordinate tray routes with other services to prevent interference with plumbing, HVAC, or structural elements .
