 - **Centralized:** Place the splitter near the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) to simplify management and maintenance. Suitable for high-density areas but may require longer fiber runs.
 - **Distributed:** Use multiple splitters closer to end-users to reduce fiber usage and signal loss. This is ideal for scattered or expanding networks.
- **Mounting:** Use appropriate enclosures or racks to protect the splitter from environmental factors and physical damage.
