

How to wire a household grounding distribution box

Proper grounding in a household distribution box ensures electrical safety by providing a low-resistance path for fault currents to the earth and bonding all metal parts to prevent shock hazards.

Key Components of a Grounding System

- **Grounding Electrode:** Typically an 8-foot copper-clad steel rod driven into the earth near the main panel, or a concrete-encased electrode (Ufer ground) embedded in the foundation .
- **Grounding Electrode Conductor (GEC):** A copper wire connecting the main panel to the grounding electrode. For a 200-amp service, a #4 AWG copper conductor is commonly used .
- **Ground Bus Bar:** Located inside the main panel, this bar collects all grounding wires from circuits, appliances, and bonding connections .
- **Bonding Wires:** Connect all exposed metal parts, including water and gas pipes, to the grounding system to maintain equal electrical potential .

Installation and Wiring Practices

- **Locate the Main Panel:** Identify the thick bare or green-insulated wire leaving the panel toward the grounding electrode .
- **Install Grounding Electrode:** Drive the rod fully into the earth, leaving only a few inches exposed. If a single rod does not achieve 25 ohms or less resistance, install a second rod .
