Article Overview

A 1.6-meter wide cable tray requires robust structural support, typically using suspended or wall-mounted brackets spaced according to load and tray type, ensuring compliance with standards like NEC 392 and BS EN 61537.

Support Spacing and Load Considerations

For wide cable trays such as 1.6 meters, support spacing is critical to prevent sagging and maintain structural integrity. Ladder-type trays generally allow spans of 1.5 to 2 meters between supports for heavy power cables, while ventilated troughs may require closer spacing due to continuous cable load. The exact spacing depends on:

- Tray material (steel, aluminum, or FRP)
- Cable weight and fill
- Environmental factors (vibration, wind, or seismic activity) Supports must be designed to withstand imposed loads, including the weight of cables, potential short-circuit forces, and environmental loads like wind or snow.

Types of Supports

- **Suspended Supports:** Rods or threaded hangers from ceilings, often with crossbars to distribute load evenly. Center suspensions are recommended for very wide trays to prevent bending.
- **Wall-Mounted Brackets:** Used when trays run along walls; brackets should be reinforced and spaced to handle the tray width and cable weight.
