Pre-Installation Requirements

Consider modular and multipurpose products like the ABB MNS® distribution board, which allows for wall or floor mounting, front access, and expansion capabilities. Ensure the enclosure has adequate protection (IP54 or higher) and is resistant to environmental factors such as humidity or chemical exposure.
