

Installation of cable tray supports in Central Asia



Article Overview

Proper installation of cable tray supports involves selecting suitable materials, following approved shop drawings, ensuring structural integrity, and complying with safety and environmental standards.

Material Selection and Preparation

Cable tray supports are typically made of steel or stainless steel, often with galvanization or powder coating to resist corrosion, which is crucial in Central Asia's diverse climates ranging from arid deserts to humid regions (OBO CMS guide) . Aluminum trays may also be used for lightweight applications due to their corrosion resistance and ease of handling (ABB Technical Guide) . All materials should be inspected upon delivery for damage, coating integrity, and compliance with approved submittals before installation (Planning Engineer, Method Statement) .

Support Types and Mounting

Supports include wall brackets, suspended supports, and center suspensions, designed to carry the weight of cable trays and fittings while maintaining alignment and stability (OBO CMS guide) . Mounting elements such as plates or clamps are used to attach trays to structural elements like ceilings, walls, or steel beams. Supports must be spaced according to manufacturer recommendations, typically 1.5 to 3 meters for horizontal runs, and adjusted for heavier loads or long spans (Planning Engineer) .
