

# Installation of the Household Circuit Distribution Box

For typical homes, boxes handle single-phase power and contain 6 to 24 circuits.

### Placement and Accessibility

Install the box in a dry, ventilated, and easily accessible location, typically around 1.5 meters above the floor. Avoid proximity to water, flammable, explosive, or corrosive substances. Ensure it is close to the main power supply for easier connection and maintenance. Outdoor installations require waterproof enclosures.

### Wiring and Circuit Connections

- **Wire Preparation:** Strip insulation to expose conductors, leaving appropriate lengths for connection.
- **Circuit Breakers:** Install individual breakers for each circuit according to household load requirements. Advanced setups may include RCDs or RCBOs for additional protection.
