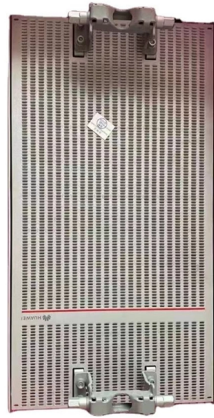


Introduction to Optical Cable Types

Optical cables, or fiber optic cables, are primarily classified into single-mode and multimode types, each designed for specific distances, bandwidths, and applications.

Main Types of Optical Cables

1. **Single-Mode Fiber (SMF)** Single-mode fibers have a small core, typically around 9 microns, allowing only one light mode to propagate. This minimizes signal loss and enables long-distance, high-speed data transmission, making them ideal for telecommunications, long-haul networks, and high-bandwidth applications. Single-mode fibers usually use laser light sources for precise transmission over distances that can exceed tens of kilometers . 2. **Multimode Fiber (MMF)** Multimode fibers have a larger core, usually 50–62.5 microns, allowing multiple light modes to travel simultaneously. This makes them suitable for shorter distances, such as within buildings, campuses, or data centers. Multimode fibers often use LED light sources and are more cost-effective for local area networks, though they experience modal dispersion, which limits their maximum transmission distance .

Cable Construction Types

1. **Loose-Tube Cables** These cables have fibers housed in protective tubes filled with gel or water-blocking material. They are designed for outdoor environments and long-distance installations, providing protection against moisture, temperature changes, and mechanical stress . 2. **Tight-Buffered Cables** In tight-buffered cables, each fiber is coated with a protective layer that makes the cable easier to handle and terminate. These are commonly used for indoor applications, such as building backbones or interconnects, where flexibility and ease of installation are important .
