What is a Distribution Box?

A distribution box (DB box), also known as a distribution board or electrical panel, is an enclosure that receives electrical power from a main supply and distributes it to multiple circuits within a building or facility. It houses protective devices such as circuit breakers, fuses, busbars, and residual current devices (RCDs), which safeguard the system against overloads, short circuits, and electrical faults, ensuring both equipment and user safety .

Understanding Capacity

The capacity of a distribution box refers to its ability to handle a specific electrical load, usually expressed in amperes (A). This capacity depends on several factors:

- **Rated Current:** The maximum current the DB box can safely carry without overheating. Residential boxes typically range from 40A to 100A, while industrial or commercial boxes may exceed 400A .
- **Number of Circuits:** The total number of downstream circuits the box can accommodate, which affects load distribution and safety. Residential boxes often support 6–24 circuits, whereas industrial boxes may support dozens of circuits .
- **Voltage Level:** Single-phase boxes are common in homes, while three-phase boxes are used in industrial or large commercial facilities requiring higher power capacity .
