Unlike cable trays where individual cables are routed, busbar duct is a complete, factory-assembled system. Sections are manufactured to standard lengths (typically 1–3 m) and connected on-site. A busbar trunking system is a prefabricated power distribution assembly used to transport and distribute electrical energy through a tested enclosure-and-conductor arrangement. In IEC practice, it sits within the IEC 61439 family, with particular requirements for low-voltage BTS. When power has to be distributed around a building, there are two main approaches: traditional cables run on trays and in conduits, or busbar trunking — a prefabricated system of solid conductors enclosed in a metal housing. Both deliver power reliably, but they differ in flexibility, space. The term cableway refers to conductors and/or cables together with the means of support and protection, etc. for example : cable trays, ladders, ducts, trenches, and so on. are all “cableways”. Compared with conventional cable arrangements, they offer improved short-circuit performance, better space utilization, lower voltage drop in many applications, and strong.
