The LC connector features a 1.25mm ceramic ferrule, which is half the size of SC connectors, allowing for higher port density in patch panels, transceivers, and networking equipment . The connector uses a push-pull latch mechanism for secure and easy insertion and removal, ensuring precise fiber alignment and minimal signal loss .

- **Compact Size:** Half the dimension of SC connectors, ideal for high-density applications .
- **Low Insertion Loss:** Optimized ferrule geometry and six-position tuning reduce signal loss and improve optical performance .
- **Versatility:** Available as pre-assembled one-piece connectors for quick field installation or multi-piece connectors for factory assembly .
- **Duplex Capability:** Supports duplex fiber links, making it suitable for 10G to 400G duplex SMF/MMF connections .
