Key Components of Protection

1. External Lightning Protection

- **Air Terminals (Lightning Rods):** Installed on the building roof or near critical equipment to intercept direct lightning strikes and provide a low-resistance path to the ground .
- **Down Conductors:** Carry the lightning current safely from the air terminals to the earthing system. Conductors should have low inductance and be routed to minimize sharp bends .
- **Earthing System:** A robust grounding network ensures that the lightning current dissipates safely into the soil, reducing the risk of structural damage and electrical hazards .

2. Internal Lightning and Surge Protection

- **Surge Protection Devices (SPDs):** Installed at distribution boxes to divert transient overvoltages caused by lightning or switching events directly to the grounding system. Metal oxide varistor (MOV) SPDs are commonly used in industrial panels .
- **Equipotential Bonding:** All metallic parts, including distribution boxes, cable trays, and structural steel, should be bonded to the grounding system to prevent dangerous potential differences .
