Common Causes of Optical Cable Failures

Physical Damage: Accidental impacts during installation, construction, excavation, or vandalism can break or crush fibers, disrupting signal transmission. Protective conduits, proper burial depth, and warning signs help mitigate these risks . **Bend Radius Violations:** Exceeding the minimum bend radius causes microbends or macrobends, leading to light leakage and attenuation. Using bend-insensitive fibers and proper cable management prevents this . **Connector and Splice Issues:** Contamination, misalignment, or poor termination at connectors and splices increases insertion loss and reflectance. Regular inspection, cleaning, and high-quality splicing equipment are essential . **Environmental Factors:** Extreme temperatures, moisture ingress, rodent damage, and mechanical stress from heavy equipment or construction can degrade cables. Selecting temperature-rated, armored, or moisture-resistant cables and proper routing reduces failures . **Aging and Degradation:** Over time, fibers can deteriorate due to mechanical stress, UV exposure, or chemical contamination, increasing attenuation. Routine monitoring and maintenance help identify issues before major failures occur .

Symptoms of Major Failures

- Intermittent or complete signal loss
- High insertion loss or unusual reflectance
