- **System Coordination Verification:** SOE helps verify that relays and breakers operated in the correct order according to the protection scheme, ensuring proper coordination and avoiding unnecessary outages.
- **Integration with SCADA and DFR:** Modern protection systems integrate SOE with SCADA systems and digital fault recorders (DFRs) to provide synchronized, high-resolution event data for comprehensive system monitoring.
