Space Optimization: Avoid overcrowding by allocating sufficient space for each cable type. Use separators or dividers within trays to maintain order and improve airflow, which helps prevent overheating . 6. Protective Measures: Install grommets or edge protectors where cables pass through tray edges to prevent abrasion. Ensure cables are not exposed to moisture or excessive heat, which can degrade insulation .
