

Motor thermal relay protection device

A motor thermal relay protection device safeguards electric motors from overheating by monitoring current and automatically disconnecting power during sustained overloads.

Overview

A motor thermal relay, also known as a thermal overload relay, is an electromechanical protection device designed to prevent damage to electric motors caused by excessive current or prolonged overload conditions . Unlike circuit breakers that provide instantaneous protection, thermal relays operate on a time-delay principle, allowing temporary surges, such as motor startup currents, while protecting against continuous overloads that could harm the motor .

Working Principle

Thermal relays function based on the thermal effect of electric current. The current flowing to the motor passes through a bimetallic strip or other thermal sensing element. As the current exceeds normal operating levels, the strip heats up and bends due to the different expansion rates of the metals. When the bending reaches a critical point, it triggers a tripping mechanism that interrupts the motor circuit, stopping current flow and preventing overheating . Some relays offer automatic reset, while others require manual intervention after tripping .

Key Components and Technologies

- Bimetallic strips: Mechanical elements that bend with heat to trigger the relay .
- PTC thermistors, RTDs, or KTY/PT1000 sensors: Electronic sensors that measure motor winding temperature and provide input to protection circuits .
