

National Standard for Indoor Lighting Distribution Boxes



Article Overview

Indoor lighting distribution boxes must comply with ANSI/UL, IEC, and NEMA standards, ensuring safe installation, environmental protection, and structural support for luminaires.

Regulatory and Safety Standards

Indoor lighting distribution boxes, also referred to as outlet or junction boxes, are required to meet several national and international standards. In the United States, these include ANSI/UL 50, UL 514A, UL 514B, and UL 514C, which cover enclosure construction, safety, and suitability for electrical installations. Additionally, NFPA 70 (National Electrical Code) provides guidelines for installation, grounding, and protection against electrical hazards. For maritime or specialized applications, IEC standards such as IEC 60092-101, 201, 306, 352, 401, and 502 may apply, ensuring boxes are suitable for specific environmental conditions and electrical loads (46 CFR 111.81-1) .

NEMA Enclosure Types

The National Electrical Manufacturers Association (NEMA) defines enclosure types to indicate the degree of protection against solid objects, water ingress, and environmental hazards. For indoor lighting distribution boxes, the most relevant types are:

- Type 1: Indoor use, protects personnel from contact with hazardous parts and equipment from falling dirt.
