

Optical Module Mounting Socket Design Dimensions



Article Overview

Optical module mounting sockets are designed according to standard rack units (RU) and module widths, with specific spacing and fiber routing considerations for SFP, XFP, CFP, and LGX-style modules.

Standard Rack Unit and Module Accommodation

Optical module mounting brackets are typically designed to fit standard 19-inch racks. The rack unit (RU) height determines how many modules can be mounted:

- 4 RU bracket: Accommodates 14 single-wide modules, 7 double-wide modules, or any combination not exceeding 14 module-width spaces .
- 2 RU bracket: Accommodates 6 single-wide or 3 double-wide modules .
- 1 RU bracket: Accommodates 3 single-wide modules . These brackets often include fiber routing guides to manage fiber entry and exit, ensuring proper bend radius and minimizing signal loss .

Module Width and Mounting Considerations

- Single-wide modules: Standard small form-factor pluggable (SFP, SFP+) modules.
- Double-wide modules: Larger modules such as XFP or CFP variants.
- Flush mount vs recessed versions: Brackets may be designed to allow modules to sit flush with the front panel or recessed for additional protection and airflow management .
