

Patch wire to drop fiber optic cable splicing



Article Overview

To connect a patch cord to a drop fiber optic cable, you can use either mechanical or fusion splicing, ensuring precise fiber alignment and proper protection to minimize signal loss.

Tools and Materials Needed

- Fiber cleaver and fiber stripper for precise cutting and stripping of fibers ()
- Drop cable stripper to remove the outer jacket and Kevlar strength members ()
- Alcohol sprayer for cleaning fiber ends ()
- Kevlar scissors or cutters to trim strength members ()
- Fiber sleeves or protective heat-shrink tubes for splice protection ()
- Fusion splicer or mechanical splice unit depending on the chosen method ()

Step-by-Step Process

1. Prepare the Drop Cable

- Remove the outer jacket carefully using a drop cable stripper without damaging the inner fibers ().
- Cut and remove the Kevlar strength members using specialized cutters.
- Strip the fiber buffer coating using a 900µm buffer remover in small increments to avoid breaking the fiber ().
