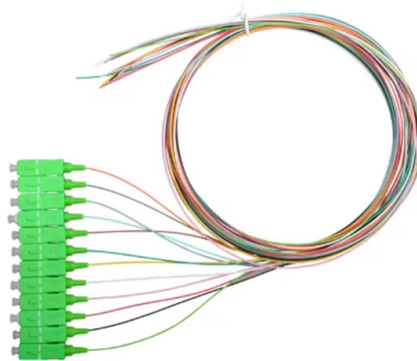

Intelligent patch panels automate these processes through sensor strips, RFID technology, and automated infrastructure management (AIM) systems, allowing real-time detection of patch cord connections, Moves, Adds, and Changes (MACs), and reducing downtime . This automation significantly improves operational efficiency and reduces the risk of network failures.
