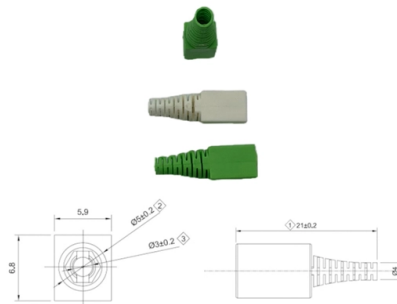


PoE switch ground wire
