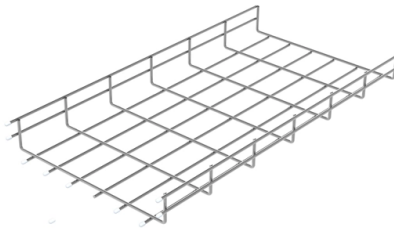

A PoE circuit is made up of three parts: Power Sourcing Equipment (PSE), which injects power over the same cabling as the data signals. This is typically a PoE-enabled network switch but can also be a midspan injector used in instances where the switch is not capable of supplying power. The most obvious advantage of using a PoE switch is that it offers great flexibility for installation and relocation in places where no power is present, which greatly improves the scalability of network. A PoE switch is a network switch that utilizes PoE technology to transmit power and data over the same Ethernet cable to powered devices such as IP cameras, wireless access points, and VoIP phones, simplifying installation and reducing maintenance costs.
