FBG temperature sensors vary in price based on packaging, temperature range, and environmental protection. Bare fiber sensors are the most economical, suitable for direct fiber installation, while packaged sensors with protective housings are more expensive but offer durability and easier installation in harsh environments . Standard temperature ranges (-40°C to 300°C) are moderately priced, whereas high-temperature sensors (400°C to 800°C) require specialized coatings and packaging, significantly increasing cost .

Multi-Point and Distributed Systems

For applications requiring multiple measurement points, multi-point FBG arrays reduce the per-sensor cost when 8, 16, or 32 sensors are deployed on a single fiber . Distributed temperature sensing systems, which provide continuous temperature profiles along cables or structures, are more expensive but offer high spatial resolution and detailed monitoring capabilities .
