

Regulations for the Maintenance and Management of Optical Fiber Cables



Article Overview

Maintenance and management of optical fiber cables are governed by international standards such as ITU-T L.25, IEC 60794 series, and ITU-T G.984, which define operational procedures, safety, testing, and documentation requirements.

International Standards and Recommendations

ITU-T L.25 provides general guidance on the maintenance and operation of optical fiber cable networks, focusing on non-gas pressurized terrestrial networks. It defines the functions of network maintenance, including inspection, fault detection, and preventive measures, while excluding transmission equipment and submarine cables (covered under ITU-T G.979) (ITU-T L.25) . Compliance is voluntary but mandatory provisions ensure interoperability and applicability. ITU-T G.984 addresses Passive Optical Networks (PON), particularly GPON systems, and outlines best practices for labeling, infrastructure documentation, and operational management, which are critical for both maintenance and future network expansion (splice.me) . IEC TR 62263:2024 and the IEC 60794 series provide technical specifications for optical fiber cables, including all-dielectric self-supporting (ADSS) cables, environmental testing, and safety considerations. These standards cover cable construction, installation, and handling to minimize electrical hazards and ensure long-term reliability (IEC TR 62263, Commscope) .
