

Relay Protection Action Type TRP



Article Overview

TRP in relay protection refers to a Time-Delayed or Trip Relay Protection action that initiates a circuit breaker trip after a preset delay when abnormal conditions are detected.

Overview of TRP

TRP, or Time-Delayed Trip Protection, is a type of protective relay action designed to isolate faults in electrical circuits while allowing transient disturbances to clear without unnecessary tripping. The relay monitors electrical quantities such as current, voltage, or frequency, and only triggers the trip if the abnormal condition persists beyond a preset time delay. This ensures selective and coordinated protection in power systems, preventing unnecessary outages and maintaining system stability .

Operating Principle

- **Detection:** The relay continuously monitors the actuating quantity (current or voltage). When the measured value exceeds the relay's pickup threshold, the relay begins timing.
- **Time Delay:** The TRP function introduces a deliberate delay before initiating the trip, allowing temporary surges or inrush currents to pass without tripping the breaker.
- **Trip Action:** If the abnormal condition persists beyond the set delay, the relay closes its contacts, completing the trip coil circuit of the circuit breaker, which then isolates the faulty section .
