Types of Fiber Optic Cables on Power Lines

- ADSS (All-Dielectric Self-Supporting) Cables: Standalone cables that can span long distances and withstand high tension without additional support . These cables are designed to endure environmental stress, including temperature extremes, ice, and abrasion from contact with conductors .

Safety Considerations

- Electrical Hazards: Work near energized power lines requires strict adherence to electrical safety standards. Only trained personnel should perform removal.
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Safety helmets, gloves, glasses, and insulated tools are essential. Workers should also use fall protection when working at height .
- Cable Integrity: Fiber optic cables are fragile; excessive bending or pulling can break the glass fibers, causing signal loss or permanent damage .
