

Requirements for cable connection distribution boxes

Site Selection and Box Placement

Distribution boxes should be installed in dry, well-ventilated, and accessible areas to prevent overheating and allow easy inspection and maintenance. The typical installation height is 1.5 to 1.8 meters above the ground for convenient operation. Outdoor installations require waterproof enclosures with appropriate IP or NEMA ratings to protect against moisture and dust .

Cable and Wiring Requirements

- **Wire Type and Gauge:** Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load current. The wire gauge must match the circuit breaker rating to prevent overheating .
- **Stripping and Termination:** Strip wires carefully and connect them to the phase, neutral, and ground terminals. Ensure tight, secure connections to avoid arcing or loose contacts .
- **Cable Entry:** All cable inlets and cover joints should be sealed properly to prevent gaps, moisture ingress, or dust accumulation .
- **Neat Arrangement:** Arrange cables neatly inside the box to allow heat dissipation and facilitate future maintenance. Use cable ties or DIN rails where applicable .
