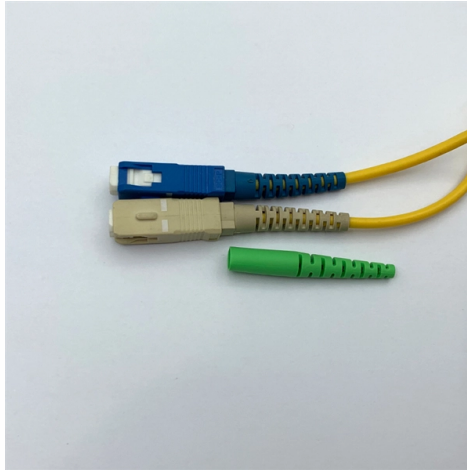


Requirements for the burial depth of road optical cables



Article Overview

Fiber optic cables under roads are typically buried at depths of 24 to 48 inches (60-120 cm), depending on traffic load, soil conditions, and local regulations.

Recommended Technical Depths

For direct-buried fiber optic cables, the typical burial depth ranges from 12 to 36 inches (30-90 cm), with deeper installations required in high-load areas such as roads or backbone routes, where depths can reach 48 inches (120 cm) or more to protect against traffic and soil compaction. In residential areas, shallower depths of 12 inches (30 cm) may be acceptable, but additional protection like warning tape is recommended. The International Telecommunication Union (ITU-T L.101) specifies that buried optical cables must meet performance criteria for direct burial, including protection against mechanical stress, moisture, and environmental conditions. The exact depth may vary depending on soil type, frost lines, and installation method, and should be agreed upon between the customer and manufacturer.

Protective Measures

- **Warning tape:** A bright orange tape, typically 3 inches (7.6 cm) wide, is recommended 12 inches (30 cm) above the cable to alert future excavators.
- **Conduits or innerducts:** In high-traffic areas, placing the cable in a conduit provides additional protection against compression and accidental damage.
- **Armored cables:** In agricultural or rural areas, armored fiber may be used to withstand mechanical stress from equipment.
