

Requirements for the installation location of electrical distribution boxes inside buildings

Electrical distribution boxes should be installed in dry, accessible, and well-ventilated locations, typically at a height of 1.2–1.5 meters from the floor, with sufficient clearance for safe operation and maintenance.
