CABLE TRAY SYSTEMS GUIDE

Commonly called the Load Class, this defines the load-carrying capability of the tray for a specific support span distance. The design and cost of the cable tray is greatly affected by this designation.

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Ladder tray should be mounted far enough off the floor or roof to allow the cables to exit through the bottom of the tray. If strut is used as a cross support, mount the strut directly to the roof or floor.
