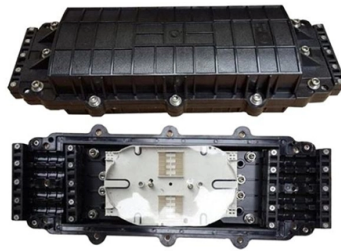


Soldering Method for Main Line of Distribution Box

A temperature-controlled soldering iron (25 to 60 watts) is needed for most common wire gauges, allowing for precise heat management. The solder should be rosin-core, which contains flux designed to clean copper oxides during heating, making it ideal for electrical applications. Why Publish?
