

Standard Requirements for Communication Optical Cable Spacing



Article Overview

Communication optical cables should maintain specific clearances from power and other conductors, typically 12 inches midspan from power lines and 30 inches at support points, following NESC, NEC, TIA, and FOA standards.

Regulatory and Industry Standards

NESC (National Electrical Safety Code) specifies midspan and support clearances for communication cables relative to power conductors. For voltages below 50 kV, midspan clearance can be 12 inches (300 mm) if the communication messenger is bonded to the supply neutral, while at support points, a 30-inch (0.75 m) clearance is maintained between the neutral conductor and the highest communication attachment .

NEC 2026 (National Electrical Code) distributes communication and limited energy cable requirements across Articles 725, 760, 770, 805, and 820. NEC emphasizes separation to prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI) and maintain signal integrity. Unshielded data cables should be separated from power cables by 12 inches, while shielded data cables require 6 inches. Data cables in metallic conduits may share pathways without additional separation .

TIA Standards such as TIA-569-E and TIA-568.0-E provide guidance for structured cabling and pathway spacing to mitigate EMI. These standards complement NEC by defining minimum spacing in cable trays, conduits, and risers .
