NEMA ratings are standards that define the types of environments an electrical enclosure can be used in. VE2 is a NEMA standard that outlines cable tray installation practices, material control, and unloading/storage standards. Single Conductor Cables enable cables of equivalent construction & conductor material to be functioned at varying maximum ampacities based on how the cables are physically placed in ladder. The International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) is the leading global organization that prepares and publishes International Standards for all electrical, electronic and related technologies. The technical content of IEC publications is kept under constant review by the IEC. Cable tray systems are defined to include, but are not limited to straight sections of [ladder type] [trough type] [solid bottom type] [channel type] cable trays, bends, tees, elbows, drop-outs, supports and accessories.
