Tariffs on imported components and materials are significantly increasing the cost of edge data center deployment, including IP67-rated enclosures and related hardware.

Impact of Tariffs on Edge Data Centers

Recent U.S. tariffs have raised costs for data center construction and equipment. A baseline 10% tariff applies to most imports, with higher rates on key goods from China (up to 125%), Taiwan (32%), and South Korea (25%), . These tariffs affect servers, networking gear, SSDs, CPUs, and electrical components, which are critical for edge data centers . For IP67-rated enclosures, which are designed to protect equipment from dust and water, tariffs on imported metals, plastics, and electronic components can increase procurement costs by 3–12%, depending on the source and material .

Cost Drivers

- **Hardware and Networking Equipment:** Tariffs on servers, memory, and networking devices increase both OEM and compatible options, impacting overall capital expenditure .
- **Construction Materials:** Steel, aluminum, and copper used in enclosures, power distribution, and cooling systems are subject to Section 232 tariffs, raising costs for IP67-rated cabinets and supporting infrastructure .
- **Supply Chain Delays:** Tariffs have prompted companies to front-load imports, causing temporary spikes in delivery times and inventory costs .
