A distribution box (also called a distribution board, breaker box, or electrical panel) is an enclosure that distributes electricity from the main supply to individual circuits, each protected by circuit breakers or fuses. Its primary purpose is to provide a safe, organized, and centralized control of electrical circuits, preventing overloads and reducing fire risks. Modern panels also allow quick identification of circuit issues, making maintenance more efficient.

Best Practices for Neat Wiring

- **Wire Routing and Layering:** Group wires by function or circuit and route them in layers. Bend wires at right angles to buses or breakers to maintain a clean layout.
- **Labeling:** Clearly label each wire at both ends to indicate the circuit it serves, such as "Kitchen A" or "2nd Floor Lights." This simplifies troubleshooting and future modifications.
- **Cable Entry and Protection:** Use cable connectors or bushings for wires entering the panel to protect insulation from sharp edges. Larger feeder cables require insulated fittings, while smaller Romex cables typically need only appropriately sized connectors.
