Connector Color Significance

In fiber optic systems, connector colors are standardized to indicate fiber type and polish style according to TIA/EIA-598-C standards. For example:

- Blue: Single-mode fiber with UPC (Ultra Physical Contact) polish
- Green: Single-mode fiber with APC (Angled Physical Contact) polish
- Beige: Multimode fiber OM1/OM2
- Aqua: Multimode fiber OM3/OM4
- Lime: Multimode fiber OM5 These colors help technicians quickly identify fiber types, maintain proper connections, and prevent signal loss due to mismatched polish styles or fiber types .

Silver Connectors

A silver or metallic connector is generally used for:

- Environmental protection: Metal housings provide durability in harsh conditions, such as outdoor conduits or industrial installations.
