Socket Types for Distribution Boxes

1. Flush-Mounted Sockets: These sockets are installed by making openings in the distribution box enclosure and are ideal for indoor or controlled environments. They cannot serve as live terminals on their own; only the associated connectors carry live current. Flush-mounted sockets are commonly used in distribution boxes for stage lighting, audio equipment, and industrial control systems, providing a neat and safe installation . 2. Surface-Mounted Sockets: These are mounted directly on the wall or the surface of the distribution box. They are easier to access and maintain, suitable for factory power distribution, server rooms, and exhibition halls. Surface-mounted sockets require sufficient space for plugging and unplugging and are often used in industrial environments . 3. Plug-In Type Circuit Breaker Sockets: For distribution boxes that house circuit breakers, plug-in type sockets are recommended. These sockets feature specialized clips that snap directly onto the busbar inside the distribution box, ensuring secure electrical contact and easy installation or replacement .

Key Considerations

- Current Rating: Industrial sockets typically come in 16A, 32A, 63A, and 125A ratings. Choose a socket that matches the load requirements of the circuits in the distribution box .
