- Powder-Coated Trays: Usually follow the same thickness range as pre-galvanized steel, with additional surface protection .
- Alu-Zinc + Magnesium Coated Trays: Thicknesses similar to steel trays, offering self-healing properties on cut edges for aggressive environments .

- HRCA (Hot Rolled Close Annealed) Steel: Meets IS2062 standard, used for structural strength .
- CRCA (Cold Rolled Close Annealed) Steel: Meets IS513 standard, suitable for precise fabrication .
