

Three switches connected by fiber optic cable



Article Overview

Three switches can be connected using fiber optic cables in either a star or ring topology, with proper SFP modules and fiber type ensuring reliable communication.

Topology Options

Star Topology:

- Each remote switch connects directly to a central switch (core switch).
- Provides high performance and isolation; if one link fails, other switches remain unaffected.
- Requires one fiber strand per connection, so for three switches, three separate fibers or strands are needed ().

Ring Topology:

- Switches are connected in a loop, allowing data to travel in both directions.
- Offers redundancy; if one link fails, traffic can reroute the opposite way ().
- More complex to configure and may require ring protection protocols to prevent broadcast storms.

Daisy Chain (Cascading):

- Core switch connects to Switch A, which connects to Switch B, then Switch C.
- Simpler cabling but a failure in an intermediate switch can disrupt downstream connectivity ().
