

What are the uses of a switch splitter

A splitter cannot fully function as a switch because it only shares a single cable between two devices without managing network traffic, though a switch can replace a splitter by providing additional ports and intelligent traffic handling.

Key Differences Between Splitters and Switches

Ethernet Splitter:

- A simple, low-cost device that divides one Ethernet cable into two connections.
- Does not manage traffic or increase total bandwidth; both devices share the same cable bandwidth, which can reduce performance if used simultaneously .
- Requires a matching splitter at the other end to "unsplit" the connection.
- Typically limited to 100 Mbps on Cat5e cables and cannot support modern Gigabit speeds unless active electronics are included .

Ethernet Switch:

- An intelligent device that connects multiple devices and manages network traffic using MAC addresses, forwarding data only to the intended recipient .

- Maintains full bandwidth for each connected device and allows simultaneous communication without collisions .

- Can be unmanaged (plug-and-play) or managed (with features like VLANs, QoS, and port control).

- Expands a single router port into multiple high-speed connections without requiring a second splitter .
