

What color is best for grounding a distribution box

The standard color for grounding (equipment grounding conductor) in a distribution box is green, green with yellow stripes, or bare copper.

Ground Wire Color Standards

In the United States, the equipment grounding conductor (EGC) must be easily distinguishable from hot and neutral wires to ensure safety and compliance with the National Electrical Code (NEC). The accepted colors are:

- Solid green
- Green with yellow stripes
- Bare copper These colors are reserved exclusively for grounding and should never be white or gray, which are designated for neutral conductors, or any other color used for hot wires (black, red, blue, etc.), .

Importance of Correct Grounding Color

Using the correct color for the ground wire is not just cosmetic—it:

- Ensures safety by clearly identifying the path to earth for fault currents .
- Prevents confusion during installation, maintenance, or troubleshooting .
- Complies with NEC Article 250.119, which sets identification rules for equipment grounding conductors .
