Modern fiber systems achieve unprecedented capacity through wavelength-division multiplexing (WDM), in which multiple wavelengths simultaneously carry separate data streams over a single fiber strand. Bandwidth is the maximum amount of data that can be transferred between two. Most fiber providers offer plans with speeds of at least Gbps (1,000 Mbps), but this is by no means the limit to fiber technology. For example: 1 gigabit = 1000 Mbps, so 1 gig internet speed is considered ultra-fast. Fiber optic internet is currently the fastest and most reliable internet.
